

Hanging Basket Love

The two most important keys to keeping your hanging basket happy, lush, and blooming, are water and fertilizer. Because of the small container your flowers are in, they need a steady supply of water and nutrients. Expect to water your basket every day during the heat of summer, and fertilize once a week. Also, set aside a little time every week or two to deadhead faded flowers, which will encourage more blooms.
